

LESSON PLAN TITLE: The Power of Friendship

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Grade Level: 3rd-12th

Model Works Used: Count on Me Bruno Mars

Literary Learning objective(s): Students will be able to identify what provides them with support and connection in the context of friendships and analyze song lyrics to express the impact of

music.

Themes: Friendship, support

MDE/SEL Standards: Considering the well being of others, Self Awareness, Empathy

Materials Needed: pen, paper, notebook and copy of song lyrics

Opening Activity

Questions to ponder: What makes you enjoy a song? Is it that it has a good sound? Interesting words? When you listen to a song, do you really listen to the words? How often do you think about the meaning of a song?

Pre-Discussion

Friendships free write: Describe a best friend. What makes them a best friend? Why is their friendship important?

Model Poem Discussion

Listen to Count on Me by Bruno Mars

Prewriting

What are the reasons you listen to music? How did listening to this music make you feel? What is your go to song when you are feeling down?

Writing Prompt

Based on the song lyrics, do you have a friend like this? Are you a friend like this? Write a poem as dedicated to a friend or loved one that helped support you in a time of need. Write 5-7 lines about this person.



Share / Reflect

How did it feel to write this poem? Share your poem with your friend by calling or texting or emailing it to them.
