DURATION: 1.5 hours GRADE LEVEL: Middle & High School WRITING LEVEL: All levels FOCUS: magic, sacrifice, power of the written word KEY TERMS: metaphor, simile

WORKSHEET | Mix-n-Match

KEY TERMS

- SIMILE: a figure of speech that compares two unlike things using the words like or as.
- **METAPHOR**: a figure of speech used to compare two things that aren't alike but do have something in common.

QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER

- Do you believe the spell will be used for good or bad? What lines make you say that?
- The witches brew calls for sacrifices for the magic to be activated. Why do you think that is? Who or what do you think the sacrifices are being made to?
- The poem doesn't say what the spell will do once it is finished. What are your predictions on what the spell will be used for?

Writing Prompt | 20 minutes

Write a spell. Use the similes/metaphors you developed during check-in as a guide for one or more lines to build the poem around. What do you want to change and how will the magic change it?

<u>OR</u> Write about the sacrifices you have made. What have you gotten in return? Was the sacrifice(s) worth it?

<u>OR</u> Write a step-by-step guide to How to Unleash Your Magic.
